

SMARTER COLLABORATION QUICK TIPS

Gardner & Co.'s Top 5 Ways to Collaborate Smarter through Zoom

1. Invite only the people who need to be there.

2. Provide an agenda ahead of time so that participants know what to expect (especially critical for introverts and non-native speakers, among others).

3. Make sure everyone contributes (research on the collective intelligence shows that groups perform higher when participation is more equal).

4. Encourage people to use the chat function if they so prefer.

5. Schedule meetings for 25 or 50 minutes (rather than a half- or full hour) so that people have time to finish their notes or stick around for an informal chat.
