The Need for Swift Trust in Dynamic Teams - and How to Get It

Reflecting on Dr. Heidi K. Gardner's recent session with the MD Anderson Cancer Center, we are struck by how crucial it is for dynamic medical teams to develop "swift trust." Dr. Gardner explored how doctors, nurses, and technicians can fuel faith in one another – even before deeply knowing them. This trust breeds smarter collaboration, in turn leading to better patient care.

As surgical and other teams morph (based on scheduling, new hires, etc.), creating swift trust requires members to:

- Focus more on the task at hand, less on personalities
- Clarify roles in this context (the "top dog" on one team might be a "mere" member on another, which demands a change in expectations about power/deference)
- Demonstrate trustworthiness reputations matter
- Presume others are trustworthy (check biases: pressure makes it more likely to unconsciously trust people whom we perceive as our in group – what psychologists call "homophily")



Other hot topics covered during the session included maintaining collaboration under stress, and reducing employee burnout.




